May 25, 2020

On May 15, 2020, the provincial government announced a partial resumption of in-class instruction beginning June 1, 2020. On May 19, 2020, you received a letter from the school administration regarding in-class attendance is voluntary and the decision rests with the families.

I would like to thank you for letting your child's teacher know about your decision on sending your child to school starting June 1, 2020. Based on your feedback, our school administrative team is in a better position to develop a tentative plan to provide in-class instruction for your children.

If you have decided not to send your child to school during the last month of this 2019-2020 academic year, your child will continue receiving remote learning instructions from their respective teachers as usual.

If you are planning to send your child to school starting June 1, 2020, your child will receive direct teacher support for their remote learning assignments. To allow teachers to continue offering direct support and continued remote learning, classroom instruction will look different than it has in the past.

Efforts will be made to keep students with their usual teacher. However, this may not be possible for every class. A staff decision will be made in consideration of the health and safety of students and staff.

Students will be assessed based on their learning progress regardless if they attend in-class instruction or continue to learn remotely from home.

If you are a Tier 1 and Tier 2 essential service worker, you may request for up to 5 days in-class support.

We will follow the directions of the Provincial Health Officer and Work Safe BC guidelines to ensure the safety protocol for everyone. We will be:

- Screening for symptoms prior to student entry into school premises
- Limiting the class size
- Allowing for opportunities for frequent handwashing
- Access to hand sanitizer stations while maintaining physical distancing
- All classes and washrooms will be thoroughly sanitized on a regular basis
- Posting physical distance implementation guidelines on our school website.
