Controlled traffic flow throughout school

Masks required in all high traffic areas such as buses and in common areas such as hallways.

THE NEW MODEL

KINDERGARTEN TO GRADE 8

- Two divisions of each grade with their teachers, will be placed in one cohort group.
- Only one cohort group will be attending morning session at the upper foyer each day from 9:00 A.M TO 9:30 A.M.
- During non-instructional time, each cohort group will be assigned one outdoor area.
- Groups will enter and exit the classrooms at staggered times through assigned locations.
- There will be 14 cohort groups. Each group will be under 55 people.

GRADE 9 TO 12

- There will be two cohorts in our secondary divisions.
- One consisting of grades 9 & 10 and the other of grades 11 & 12.
- There will be no change in the curriculum.
- Small class size will allow subject teachers to deliver the in class instruction during their scheduled time.
- Students and staff will follow safety guidelines during the transit time from one room to another.
- Lunchtime will be staggered.
